# About the Course

**Delivery:** Face to Face (with placement) or Online (with placement)

**Duration:** 9 – 13 Months

**Accreditation:** Nationally Recognised Training

This qualification reflects the role of workers in a range of community settings and clients' homes, who provide training and support in a manner that empowers people with disabilities to achieve greater levels of independence, self reliance, community participation and wellbeing.

Workers promote a person-centred approach, work without direct supervision and may be required to supervise and/or coordinate a small team.

To achieve this qualification, the candidate must have completed at least 120 hours of work placement.

# Entry Requirements

Completion of: CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability)

**OR**

Completion of: CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability)

**OR**

Completion of: CHC30408 Certificate III in Disability PLUS the CHCSS00125 Entry to Certificate IV in Disability Support Skill Set.

# Placement Requirements

There is a 120 hour work placement requirement as part of the Certificate IV in Disability Support CHC43121.

prospED will provide support with sourcing placements and will allocate a placement for students. Placement must be taken over a minimum of 12 hours per week in a 10 week consecutive occurrence.
